

TI-84 Plus CE Calculator Loan Form

As a student of The Governor's School of Southside Virginia, your child will have access to a variety of technologically advanced equipment. As a supplement to the mathematics curriculum, we have purchased TI-84 Plus CE calculators for the students to use during the school year. Please understand that this is a loan program. The calculator issued to your child will need to be returned at the end of the school year, or whenever the student leaves GSSV. Listed below are some of the expectations that go hand-in-hand with this loan program.

- Under no circumstances should the calculator be loaned to a friend or student at the home school or anywhere else.
- No physical changes are to be made to the calculator or its cover. Students are not to etch their name or anything else in the calculator or its cover.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to program the calculators with notes or other helpful hints. This is a violation of the honor code. Therefore, if a student is caught with programs of this nature at any time, the student's home school will be notified and appropriate action will be taken.
- ❖ These calculators do not require batteries. They will need to be charged at home or at GSSV. We have docking stations at school. At home, students can charge the calculator using a computer or USB port.
- ❖ Students should promptly notify a GSSV faculty member if their calculator becomes damaged or misplaced. Students will be responsible for the replacement cost of an identical model. Failure to return or pay for replacement of the calculator could encumber a student's acquiring his/her college grades and/or transcripts.

By signing below, you and your child agree to abide by these conditions and also agree to return the calculator at the end of the GSSV Senior year, or whenever the student leaves GSSV. If not returned, you will be expected to **reimburse** GSSV **\$126.50** for its replacement.
